**SUMMARY**

The Department of Social Work is located within the Division of Social Science. The Department desires an energetic teacher-scholar who will contribute to the department's major. A commitment to collegiality, undergraduate education, scholarship, and community engagement/involvement is required. Faculty will have advising and institutional service responsibility.

**QUALIFICATIONS**

A Masters in Social Work from a CSWE accredited school, with two (2) years post MSW experience is required. A DSW, Ph.D. or ABD in Social Work or a related field is preferred. Emphasis is given to teaching courses on a mezzo and macro level such as Social Welfare Problems; Social Welfare Policy, Generalist Practice I and II. The prospective candidate may be required to teach on a micro level. In addition to the required Social Work curriculum, courses in Gerontology and Child Welfare are also taught.
